Vision Care Rider

We have added the Vision Care Rider as a supplementary coverage to your Bupa Corporate Care health plan. The Vision Care Rider covers eligible expenses for the usual, customary, and reasonable charges for a geographical area in accordance with the Contract, the Table of Benefits, the Bupa Corporate Care Membership Guide, and the conditions and benefits listed below.

The Vision Care Rider covers routine eye examinations, frames, prescription lenses, and contact lenses. It does not provide coverage for radial keratotomy and/or other procedures to correct eye refraction disorders.

This rider overrides exclusion No. 6.3 EYE EXAMINATIONS AND AIDS in the Bupa Corporate Care Membership Guide only regarding "routine eye exams, eye glasses, and contact lenses", maintaining the exclusion regarding "hearing aids, radial keratotomy, and any other procedures to correct eye refraction disorders", which remain not covered.

Area of Coverage

The area of coverage provided by this rider will be the same as the one chosen for your Bupa Corporate Care plan. Members may choose the doctor and lenses provider they prefer without any network limitations within the area of coverage.

The Claim Process

Members must pay the provider directly for all services under this rider, and submit original itemized bills and receipts afterwards with a completed claim form to Bupa or its representative. Bupa will not settle charges directly with providers, but will reimburse the member in accordance with the Table of Benefits and the usual, customary, and reasonable charges for a geographical area.
